Educate to Innovate Scholarship Scheme (Only for MS Information Security and MS Avionics Engg)

This scheme offers Full and Partial fee waiver to students with bright academic record.

AU Need-Based Financial Grant

Through this scheme, AU funds each semester needy students who face financial constraints ranging from 25% to 100% of tuition fee discounts

AU Merit-Based Scholarship

Air University offers Merit-based scholarships to all outstanding students enrolled in different undergraduate and graduate programs based on their semester results

PAF Ward concession & AU Employee Concession

AU grants 25% tuition fee discount to PAF Wards and 50% discount to AU Employees and their wards

Ehsaas Undergraduate Scholarship Project (EUSP)

Students with combined family income ≤45,000 per month can apply for this scholarship at HEC portal and the scheme is announced every year.

Fazaia Educations Welfare Scheme (FEWS)

Other than 25% Tuition Fee discount PAF Wards studying at AU campuses can avail additional funding from FEWS ranging from 25% to 100%. They can also apply for Qarz-e-Hasana from FEWS.

Punjab Education Endowment Fund Scheme (PEEF)

This scheme offers AU students avail 50% of Tuition Fee discount in each semester through PEEF as per the laid down criteria set by the Punjab Govt to sponsor the higher education of deserving students.

PM Tuition Fee Reimbursement Scheme




Out of 8000 students, more than 4000 students from low-income households received financial aid from Air University Islamabad over the past three years.

All of the students in this category who get financial aid ultimately earn a university degree. For the purpose of retaining their scholarships, students are expected to maintain a 3.00 CGPA or above during their studies for the continuation of scholarships.

Air University Flood Donation Campaign

The unprecedented rains and floods in Pakistan caused devastation in various parts of the country on 26 August 2022. The Government of Pakistan has declared a state of emergency in view of huge losses of life, property, infrastructure, livestock, and livelihoods. 33 million people have been affected by 1000 lives have been lost. The Directorate of Student Affairs at Air University has established the Flood Donation Campaign to accept donations/contributions: food items/rations, water bottles, medicines, clothes, etc. for the victims.

Air University Food Management Policy

Air University Food Management Policy is responsible for food service administration on campus. This specifically involves negotiating and implementing all food service contracts and ensuring policy compliance. Air University has established a food management committee who are responsible for complying with the requirements of the food management.

All food supplied by or delivered to the University is produced, stored, handled, and transported in accordance with relevant legislative requirements; All catering providers using the University premises are registered and approved by the University to ensure food safety standards are met and maintained and the risks associated with the provision of

food and beverages are reduced to a tolerable level.

Air University Cafeteria

In order to better serve its students, teachers, and staff. Air University has developed two and three cafeterias on its various campuses. These cafeterias provide an inexpensive range of goods to satisfy individual needs. It is kept under the direction of the university's administration division

Food Management Awareness

The Air University department has incorporated this initiative to educate students about food waste management and the conseguences of improper organization with the help of the student affairs department. In the past three years, numerous workshops and activities have been held to raise awareness about the nation's food security as well as that inside the university's bound-

Air University has made its own shaoor society for the students the main priorities of the Shaoor Society are the development of sustainable goals and other fundamental needs. They organized a campaign to inform students of the purpose of the plantation effort and the necessity to raise awareness among the students and community. 200 plants were planted by the Air University Shaoor Society as part of an effort to safeguard the environment from ozone depletion and the impact it has on agriculture and

livestock, which has a significant relationship with food security.



Food Management Feedback System

Air University has asked all departments, staff members, professors, and students for their feedback on how to improve the caliber of the meals. At the end of each month, a feedback form is given out in order to gather information regarding customer satisfaction and the performance of the food contractors. More than 6000 of the 8,000 students in our study expressed satisfaction with the food's hygienic conditions, and 85% of the faculty and staff expressed high levels of satisfaction.

Collaborations with local or global health institutions to improve health & wellbeing outcomes

Our students of Fazia Medical College (FMC) have joined organizations like SYNCH (Solidarity among Young Nations for Change). More than 40 medical colleges all over Pakistan are part of this resociety and their focus is on health, education, medical research, and welfare work. This society is working in collaboration with multiple national and internationally renowned organizations like WHO.

National and international medical Workshop and associations

Fazaia Medical College is arranging seminars, conferences, and day commemoration of international days with the collaboration of UNICEF, WHO, and the Ministry of health and coordination on reproductive and maternal health, communicable and non-communicable diseases (like Tuberculosis and cancers), immunization, breastfeeding and also working with the Scaling up nutrition (SUN) academia and research network.

Blood Donation Campaign

Air University has made its own blood donation group which helps to provide blood in the twin cities of Pakistan and its subcampuses are collaborated with Thalassemia International Federation and Sundas Foundation, Regional Blood Center and Safe Blood Transfusion Services (Hemophilia and Thalassemia Center).

The Well Park project, supported by the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research, has been launched by the Fazaia Medical College to promote good health in all of Pakistan's urban and rural areas.

Contamination of Mobile Phones of Health Care Workers of PIMS Hospital Islamabad

The Constituent College of Air University, known as Fazaia Medical College, discovered that mobile phones were extremely polluted with bacteria. A consistent guideline regarding the cleanliness practices of electronic devices and mobile phones in hospitals and healthcare facilities should be released because this could result in nosocomial infections. Our university has developed a standard operating procedure that is displayed throughout the university's main buildings.

Knowledge, Attitude, Risk Factors & Screening Practices Regarding Breast Cancer

The community medicine department of the Fazaia medical college, a constituent college of Air University Pakistan is very eager to raise awareness of breast cancer among both men and women, although it is relatively high among females. The department of Community Medicine urged the entire month of October to be devoted to raising awareness about breast cancer

Research Workshops




Computing rooms

Air University's curriculum includes 658 sustainable educational courses designed to help students expand their potential and study more effectively and provided the US \$ 64,710,949 in sustainable research funds. It has a total average per annum over the last 3 years of 30303.

Student and Faculty Feedback Mechanism

All faculty members and students are required to conduct course and faculty evaluations periodically. The teacher's evaluation is done at the end of each semester through student feedback and the performance of each faculty member is shared with the Deans and the Chair department which is disseminated to respective faculty members. On the basis of input from the Chair department, QEC organizes Professional Competency Enhancement Program for the Teachers (PCEPT) during summer vacations to improve teaching skills



Work Shop on Building Water Saving

Air University Islamabad, a workshop on Building Water Saving

Devices was held. The Robotics

& Automation Society at Air University created the first Smart Tap prototype. The prototype was well received, and the university administration requested that it be used in the ablution area and washrooms. Scrap materials were used to construct the body and all of the building components. Discarded dispenser bottles and damaged PVC pipes were used for the main body. This system is suited for use in underserved communities.



Research Analysis

As per Pakistan's standard policy for water security and purification, the various departments of the Air University conducted an extensive study on the cleansing and sanitation of water. Water should be available both inside and beyond the university's boundaries, and it should be clean, disease-free, and tested in accordance with industry standards before being made available for human consumption.

Water Recycling Program

Air University, E-9 Islamabad is located at the heart of the city, the water sewerage and the exit water are connected with the main lines of the Islamabad sewerage system. However, a portion of Air University's water is reused to water green fields and maintain the greenery of the complex. At the new South Campus, the university is already prepared a comprehensive recycled program to maintain a huge green belt and the green areas of the Campus. The university has also prepared procedures to conserve water and made channels to use rainwater for the maintenance of the grass and

Water Efficient Appliances Usage

Air University believes in a cost-effective method for growing economies while reducing energy usage. Each restroom attendant has been assigned the primary job of monitoring water use and improper use of hand washing faucets

University's Water Security

Air University has outlined all the requirements in the water policy that must be met, for instance., making sure water is used effectively every day by utilizing the economy mode, filling the dishwasher before using it, shutting off the faucets fully, and,when available and suitable, using the half-flush option on the toilet, etc.



Consumption of treated water

By Pakistan's National Drinking Water Policy, Air University is committed to providing clean drinking water to all of its employees, teachers, and students. In this regard, drinking water is normally measured every week for cleanliness purposes, and samples are collected from each department and student regarding the effects of drinking water through filters on their health, as well as suggestions for improving the drinking water system supply.

Work Shop on Building energy saving systems

Air University, an automation workshop was held for students to design an indigenous system to save electricity in household appliances. A pedestal fan was operated during the operation. It only turns on when it detects human presence nearby. The Robotics & Automation Society of Air University organized this activity

Workshops for Introducing Energy- related Technologies to

Air University helps school students get acquainted to, and gain knowledge in the field of sustainable energy by conducting different workshops, experiments and activities

Research Analysis

Our researcher team has worked on various projects, including development of; Energy Monitoring, Control and Conservation Systems, Green Construction of Smart Buildings for Sustainability, Smart agriculture systems including, an agricultural robot for performing precision operations like seed dispensing, on-spot irrigation and on-spot pesticide spraying and low cost solar powered Automated Irrigation System. The group also holds workshops to educate the next generation on the use of renewable and sustainable energy systems, highlighting the importance of using sustainable technologies.

Automated Smart Home Systems

Home automation is the automatic control and monitoring of household appliances and house features like doors, windows, fans, and so on. This system improves the standard of living at home, saves energy and money and it also provides support to elderly and disabled people in the home.

This project not only focuses on controlling the home appliances and devices automatically but it will also enable the user to control them through a web application or smartphone application

Cost-Effective Net-Zero Energy Buildings in Different Climatic

A detailed study be carried out to ascertain the wasteful usage of energy in buildings due to poor design and non-usage of the latest energy conservation technologies as well as determine the cost-effective methods of integrally incorporating the use of Renewable energy sources for producing electricity,

within the building design to meet the majority of the lighting, heating and cooling requirements of existing and new buildings.

It automatically controls the brightness of the LED lamp depending on a particular time of day, especially in cases where full level illumination is not needed, thus reducing power consumption.

The manufacturing process of building material contributes to Green House Gases such as CO2 to the atmosphere to a great extent. The natural disasters like global warming, ozone layer depletion, unexpected seasonal variations and decreasing land surface have now moved the center of attraction from development to sustainable development. Selection of appropriate building material helps to use the energy efficiently.

Building energy simulations were also carried out using TRNSYS® software for validating and comparing the actual energy consumed and optimal energy consumption resulting from building energy simulation of the existing and re-designed building.



The results highlighted that if the building had been designed with proper considerations for energy efficiency, up to 30% of energy could have been saved.





Performance Assessment



All buildings are well ventilated, built to support energy saving with coolant walls (thick walls). Solar system is being installed to decrease reliance on electricity. Sky light roof covers the open area to instead of concrete ceiling to ventilate and light the blocks. AU Kamra sub campus has installed 250 KW (extendable to 500 KW) Solar set-up. To promote the cause of Green Campus, it would be dovetailed with the Sewage Treatment, Solar Agriculture, and Rain Water Harvesting etc.

The greenhouse emission policy at Air University was created to combat air pollution and harmful chemicals that are harmful to human health as well as to lessen the severity of climate change

Workshop on Faculty Orientation




The development of a top-notch academic and administration culture is a crucial part of AU's purpose. We reward our personnel with honorarium certificates to inspire them, depending on their successful performance.




Air University Vehicle Management



Research Analysis

Contributors to CO2 Emissions

The generation and use of energy are significant contributors to CO2 emissions. Globally, approximately 30% to 40% of all energy consumption can be directly or indirectly linked to buildings. Nearly half of energy usage in buildings is linked to maintaining the thermal comfort of the inhabitants. It is concluded that the integration of the Phase Change Material (PCM) layer with the corn husk wall provides an adequate solution for low-cost and low-energy buildings

AU Green Gas House Emissions



All buildings are well ventilated and built to support energy saving with coolant walls (thick walls). The Solar system is being installed to decrease reliance on electricity. Sky light roof covers the open area instead of concrete ceiling to ventilate and light the blocks



The engineering student from our university worked on the project and really extracted power from the shallow streams using a hydrodynamic design and optimization of cycloidal vertical axis water turbine



Analysis of Vertical Axis Water Turbine for River Application

A student has created and constructed a vertical axis water turbine application for rivers. The aim is to design and fabricate a vertical axis wind turbine with automated blade angle correction (alignment of the blade to maximize lift by adjustment of angle of attack) depending on fluid speed and angle of incidence.



Solar-powered Automatic Drip Irrigation System

The variation of the spatial and temporal distribution of available water for irrigation makes significant demand on water conservation techniques. Irrigation System provides a sustainable solution to enhance water use efficiency in the agricultural fields using renewable energy. This system allows farmers to apply the right amount of water at the right



Research Analysis

Southeast Asia has a much-diversified landscape and varied natural resources, including abundant water resources. To tackle this challenge, the department of engineering at Air University has discovered that the use of micro turbines is a very feasible option considering that the power generation density of the micro turbine comes out to be approximately 2100 kWh/year/m2, with minimal adverse effects on the environment.

Rain Water Harvesting

The landscape of AU Campus lends itself to be capitalized for subject harvesting plus water catchment. The 50 feet gradient of land has a natural depression close to the downstream end. This provides the opportunity for subject capitalization consequently, a small semi-pukka basement Lake is being planned to collect Rainwater as well as water catchment holes to support the water
